VINTAGE

Our 2022 Shadow Ridge Cabernet Sauvignon is an excellent expression of the varietal with clear roots in California. Warm sunny days in the Golden State mean ripe and healthy vines, producing grapes that are bursting with flavors of fruit and spice. Cabernet Sauvignon grown in California is often more fruit-forward with ripe and dried dark fruit flavors, as well as earth, mocha and cedar—all flavors that can be found in our Shadow Ridge Cabernet!

The 2022 growing season in Central California was marked by significant weather challenges but resulted in concentrated, high-quality fruit. There was a small heatwave during harvest, but some of the later ripening fruit like Cabernet Sauvignon was able to benefit from the cooldown after the heat spike and the extra hangtime on the vines added complexity and character to the wine. Enjoy this delightfully pleasing Cabernet Sauvignon any day of the week with your friends and family at home, or at your favorite restaurant accompanying a juicy hamburger or some fresh, grilled vegetables!

TASTING & PAIRING

This 2022 Shadow Ridge Cabernet Sauvignon is the perfect wine to have around the house for any occasion. Its deep purple hue and aromas of soft spices, jammy black fruit and a hint of leather tickle the senses and prepare your palate for the first satisfying sip. This medium-bodied wine follows through with flavors of blackberries, prunes, chalk and vanilla with a soft finish that fades into cinnamon and chocolate. This is truly a special and luxurious wine in a humble package.
