

PINOT NOIR 2023



VINEYARD & VINTAGE

Sourced from the premier block of the 400-acre Los Alamos Vineyard, this Pinot Noir showcases the exceptional quality of this renowned region. The vineyard's unique combination of warm days and very cold nights provides the perfect environment for developing deep concentration and balance of flavor. The fruit was handpicked from the best vines, allowing us to select only the most expressive and ripe grapes for this vintage. In the cellar, 30% of the fruit underwent whole cluster fermentation, and traditional hand punch-downs were employed to gently extract the wine's delicate flavors and aromas. Aged for 16 months in French François Frère barrels, the wine was left on the lees, imparting additional complexity and a silky mouthfeel.

The 2023 growing season in the Los Alamos region was marked by ideal weather conditions that contributed to the fruit's remarkable depth of flavor and smooth structure. The warm days allowed the grapes to ripen fully, while the cool nights preserved their natural acidity, resulting in wines with both intensity and freshness. This vintage represents the perfect balance between power and elegance, with the cooler nights helping to retain bright, vibrant flavors. The 2023 Pinot Noir is a true reflection of the unique terroir of Los Alamos, offering an expressive and well-rounded profile that will continue to evolve gracefully with age.

TASTING & PAIRINGS

Our 2023 Pinot Noir opens with vibrant aromas of ripe cherry, red berries, and a touch of rose petal, layered with hints of baking spice and forest floor. On the palate, luscious flavors of dark chocolate, cherry cola, and French vanilla intertwine with juicy red fruit, creating a rich yet elegantly balanced profile. Silky tannins and refreshing acidity lead to a smooth, lingering finish, leaving traces of spiced oak and subtle earthiness.
