2023 ROSÉ, Paso Robles



Vibrant aromas of wild strawberries, ripe raspberries, and a hint of watermelon mingle with subtle floral notes. Bright and refreshing palate, with juicy red fruit flavors complemented by a delicate minerality and a whisper of citrus zest.

2023 PINOT GRIGIO, Edna Valley



Delightful bouquet of fresh, vibrant aromas, leading with enticing scents of ripe green apple, juicy pear and a hint of zesty citrus. Notes of succulent tropical and stone fruits like pineapple and peaches intermingle seamlessly while a touch of minerality adds depth.

2022 SAUVIGNON BLANC, Central Coast

Nuances of white peach, nectarine and lemon curd. Flavors of ripe apricots, exotic kiwi, juicy citrus and finishes with a fresh, cool minerality of honeydew melon.

2022 CHARDONNAY, Santa Barbara County



Delights the senses with its vibrant array of aromatics. Ripe peach and juicy mango mingle with zesty lemon. On the palate, flavors of stone fruit, smooth vanilla and warm buttered toast.

100% Chardonnay 63% French Oak, 37% Stainless Steel 13.9% ABV 448 cases

2022 PINOT NOIR, Santa Barbara County



Intricate aromas of ripe red berries, such as cherries and raspberries, mingle with subtle notes of earthy forest floor and a hint of floral undertones. Flavors of black cherries, cranberries, and a touch of vanilla unfold, leading to a lingering finish with a whisper of baking spices.

100% Pinot Noir 50% New French Oak for 14 months 14.9% ABV 457 cases



2022 ZINFANDEL, Paso Robles



Aromas of ripe blackberries and cherries mingle with hints of vanilla and baking spices. Rich flavors of dark plum, raspberry jam and a touch of cocoa, framed by velvety, mild tannins that provide structure and balance.

100% Zinfandel Neutral Oak for 15 months 15% ABV 626 cases

2019 CABERNET SAUVIGNON, Paso Robles



Scents of spicy pepper, silky dark chocolate, jammy black fruit, tobacco and cedar. Big flavors of dried cassis, jammy blackberry and warm baking spices.

100% Cabernet Sauvignon 40% New French Oak for 23 months 14.8% ABV 2086 cases

2019 MERLOT, Paso Robles



Highly aromatic, medium-to full-bodied wine smells of ripe raspberries and plums, sweet cedar and white pepper. Dark fruit flavors like black cherry and red plum are layered with savory herbal notes and undertones of vanilla and mocha.

100% Merlot 20% New French Oak for 23 months 14.5% ABV 465 cases



2022 PETITE SIRAH, Paso Robles



Inviting aromas of cocoa and mocha, complemented by vibrant notes of boysenberry, blackberry and blueberry. Rich flavors of plums dominate, accented by hints of smoky, dark-berried fruits.
